

LinkyNow User Manual

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Your Card, Your Link, Your Brand

1. What is LinkyNow?

LinkyNow is your digital business card. Instead of handing out paper cards that get lost or damaged, you carry a **Smart Card** with NFC technology: tap it against someone's phone (or show them the QR code) and they instantly see your information, your social media, your products, or services — no app required.

Each card activates a **Website** — a digital page you fully control from your phone or computer.

2. Activating Your Card for the First Time

Your physical card comes with a unique code. Here's how to activate it:

1. Scan the card (or open the link it carries) from your phone.
 2. If it's your first time, create an account (name, email, password), or sign in if you already have one.
 3. Once inside, go to "**Activate Plan**" in the menu.
 4. Enter the code printed on your card and save.
 5. Your plan activates automatically — no need to pay again, since the cost of your plan was already included with the physical card.
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3. Creating Your Website

Once your plan is active, go to "**My Web**" in the menu and click "**Create Web**".

3.1 Choose Your Website Type

- **Business** — for businesses (store, service, professional)
- **Personal** — individual presentation card
- **Custom** — free-form template
- **Pet** — your pet's information (for its collar/tag)
- **Medical** — emergency medical information

3.2 Fill In the Basic Information

- **Website Theme:** choose the visual design (colors and style)
- **Language:** your page's language
- **Profile Image:** your photo or logo
- **Write Web Name:** the text that will appear in your link (e.g. linkynow.com/your-business)
- **Title / Subtitle / Description:** your name or business, what you do, and a description

Note for Pet and Medical: these fields automatically relabel themselves to guide you — for example, on Pet you'll see "Pet's Name" and "Species / Breed"; on Medical you'll see "Patient Name" and "Blood Type / Emergency Contact".

Save, and your Website is now live.

4. Linking Your Smart Card to Your Website

Once your Website is created:

1. Go to **"Smart Cards"** in the menu.
2. Find your card's code in the list (it should already appear there, "claimed" to your account from the activation step).
3. Click the **"Link"** action.
4. Choose which Website or Store you want that physical card linked to.
5. Save.

From then on, every time someone scans your card, they'll land directly on that Website.

5. Editing and Customizing Your Website

Inside **"My Web" → your card → Edit**, you'll find several sections (tabs), depending on your plan:

Section	What it's for
Basic Details	Photo, name, theme, description
Social Links / Emergency Link	Your social media, WhatsApp, or phone. On Pet/Medical this is called "Emergency Link" and lets people reach you by WhatsApp or social media if they find your pet or need medical help
Payment Links	Payment links (PayPal, bank transfer, etc.)
Services	List of services you offer
Products	Simple product catalog with pricing
Galleries	Additional photos
Business Hour	Hours of operation
Contact Form	A form for people to reach you

Google Wallet pass/offer configuration (if your plan includes it)

6. My Shop (Simple Online Store)

If your plan includes a store, under “**My Shop**” you can:

1. Create your store with “**Create Shop**”.
2. Upload your products with photo and price.
3. Customers see your catalog and message you directly on **WhatsApp** to buy — there’s no shopping cart or online checkout; it’s a simple catalog built to close the sale by message.

Note: currency is fixed to **US Dollar**, and the only required field is your WhatsApp number — everything else is optional so you can publish quickly and fill in details later.

7. Your Subscription

Under “**Subscriptions**” in the menu you can see:

- Your active plan and how many days remain
- Your payment/activation history
- When your plan is about to expire, the system will notify you from the main Dashboard

If your plan came included with your physical card, you’re not charged anything at activation — only if you decide to **renew** after it expires does it get processed as a normal payment.

8. Frequently Asked Questions

Can I have more than one Website? It depends on your plan — some allow only one, others allow several.

What happens if I lose my physical card? Your Website keeps working through its regular link (linkynow.com/your-business) even without the card in hand — you can share that link directly or request a replacement card.

Can I change the design later? Yes, at any time you can go back into your Website and change the theme, photos, or information.

How do I add my Website to my phone’s home screen? From your browser (Safari on iPhone, Chrome on Android), open your link, tap the share/menu button, and choose “Add to Home Screen.” It will appear with your name and photo, just like an app.
